Gradus Esplanade 1500 primary barrier matting was installed to create a safe and attractive entrance to the newly restored St Paul's Church in London. The Grade II listed building has recently undergone a five year, £2.2million restoration programme along with an extension to the north side of the church.

Ideal for interior locations subject to medium to heavy foot and wheeled traffic, Esplanade 1500 primary barrier matting was specified in Tempestas (black) and installed in three locations throughout the church, including the new entrances to the Crypt and the extended north side, providing disabled access.

The Restoration Manager required matting that would maintain the appearance of the carefully restored flooring. By installing a matting system, the flooring is now protected from any damage caused by the debris carried on footwear, wheelchairs and pushchairs.
