Project: Combined Education Centre University Hospital of North Staffordshire

Developed as a result of the drive to educate more doctors and nurses, the new Clinical Education Centre at the University Hospital of North Staffordshire can be said to represent the future of medical education in the U.K. The project is a joint initiative between the hospital and Keele University, and the Centre is the first medical education facility to teach doctors, nurses and midwives in an integrated environment.

The Centre is housed in a new, purpose designed building within the University Hospital campus, where Gradus' Adventurer was installed in lecture theatres, libraries and conference rooms, in two different colourways - Lost Horizon and Sandstorm. Adventurer is constructed in 100 percent solution dyed nylon to allow for aggressive cleaning without colour loss, an essential requirement for applications like this, where heavy traffic is a consistent feature of the installation.
